I wish you a trip you will never forget!

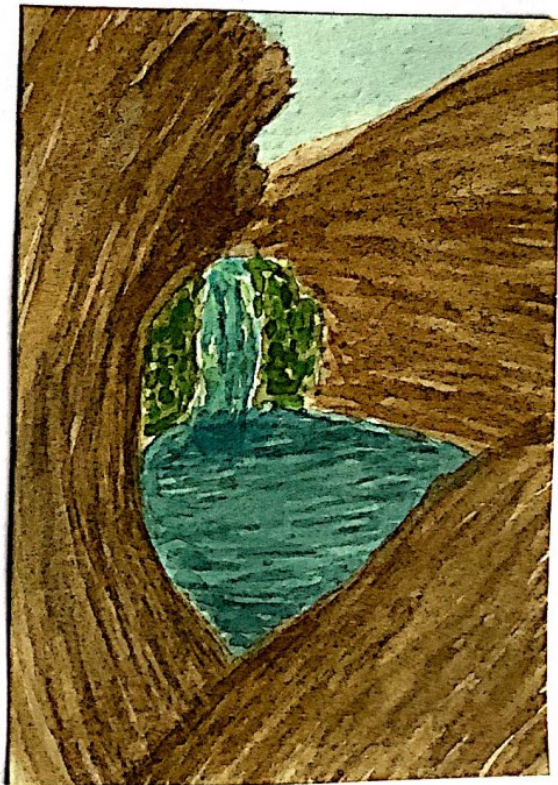
KARIJNI NATIONAL PARK

National Park, Off Weano Rd, Karijini WA 6751, Australia

The first step of the trip, is arriving at the Coondewanna airport in Western Australia. There you rent a caravan and then you are ready to go.

The first drive is only 1 hour to the Karijini Eco Retreat, located in the Karijini National Park. There you can do a lot of hikes that lead you to beautiful stone formations and little seas, hidden by the stone.

The rocks and stone, that you will find there are very old and you can see the different layers in them. Sometimes the stone is shaped by little rivers or big waterfalls, that can be 100m high.



You have spent some time at this beautiful place?

All right. Then let's go on to the next stop.

But you will have to be patient on the 7 hour drive. Maybe if you just listen to some music the time will fly by.

MEEKATHARRA

So, I see you arrived. You are going to sleep on the Meekatharra accomodation centre. It is located right at the coast.

Meekatharra has about 750 inhabitants and the name's translation is „village with less water“. A lot of Aboriginal poeple live there, so if you are interested in the Aboriginal culture there is the best place to meet a nice Aborigine and learn about their traditions and lifestyle.



I hope you had an interesting and wonderful time and are ready to continue with youre adventure. Let's drive to the Nambung National Park, to be more specific, to the Nambung Station Stay, where you are going to stay the next few nights. The drive is 7 hours.

NAMBUNG NATIONAL PARK

Nambung National Park is near Cervantes and is 245 km big.

Nambung National Park is not a secret place. A lot of people come there, to see the Pinnacles, limestone pillars that can be 4 m high. But that type of landscape is only 4 square km of the park.

The rest of the park is a sand desert with blue fanflowers, and eucalyptus.



When you are ready to tear yourself away from this stunning and unique view, we can go on to the next stop. Widgiemooltha. You can stay on the Widgiemooltha Tavern & Roadhouse. See you there after the 8 hours drive!

GAWLER RANGES

Now we already are in South Australia. The area you are in right now is Gawler Ranges. You won't find there many people except some farmers. But the nature is just breath taking. You will see stones in shapes, that you wouldn't even believe could be possible.

You really have to explore this unique landscape, for example by hiking.



Are you finished processing all these new impressions? All right, then we will meet again at our next stop. This night, you can't stay in your caravan. There is a hotel room at the Adelaide Central YHA for you. Maybe you even are a bit lucky to sleep in a comfortable bed after all this camping.

The drive there is an 7-hour drive.

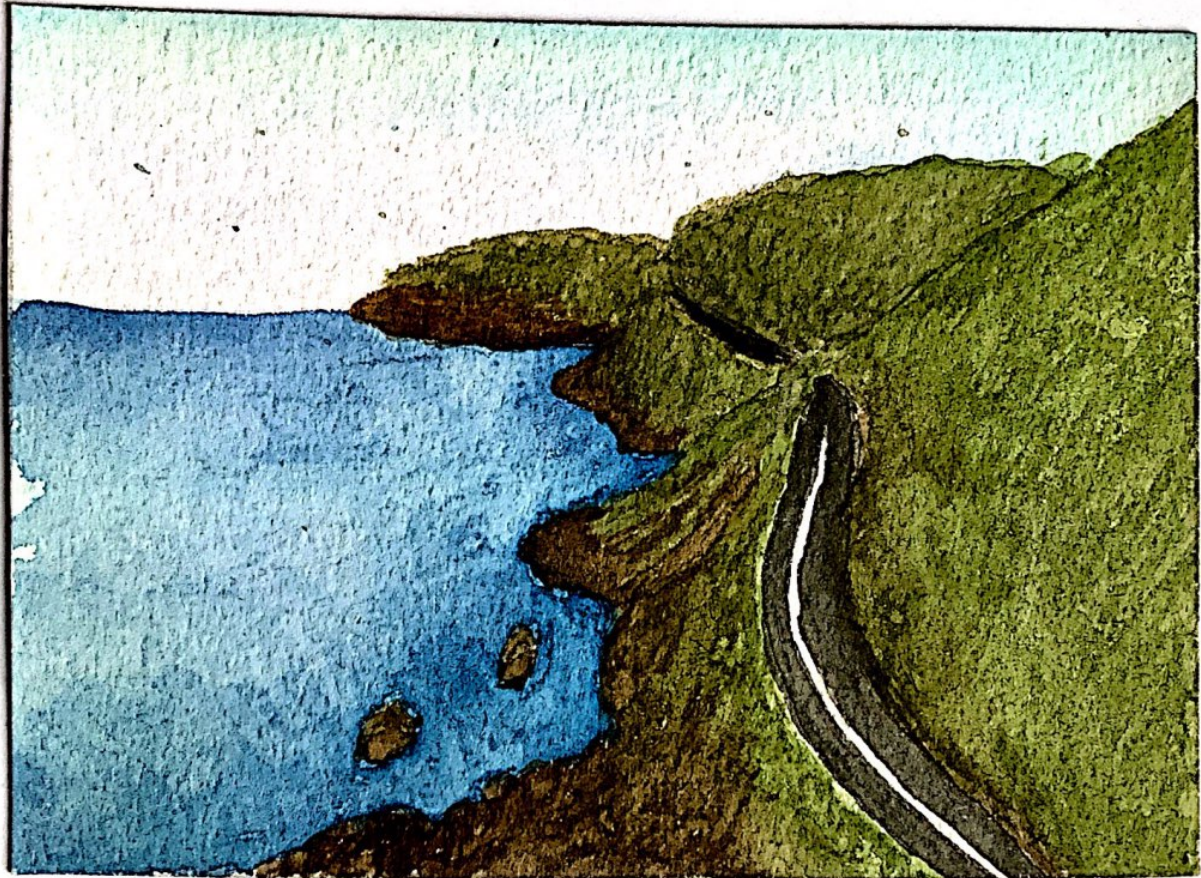
Then let's see what we have for the end of your adventure.
